  - K. Mosaic (any medium)

**Senior Living Community Rules:** It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to be familiar with the **General Rules and Regulations** link here which apply to all Nebraska State Fair open class domestic departments as well as the specific rules for each department.

## Additional Rules Specific to the Senior Living Community Entries:

- Each exhibitor may have up to ten entries in each class.
- All entries must be accompanied with a label with the name of the Senior Living Community and the name of the resident.
- Exhibitors not receiving placing ribbons will receive participation ribbons.
- All entries will be awarded sweepstakes points as detailed on the last page.
- Each exhibitor is eligible to purchase five reduced price exhibitor tickets for family. Email [statefaired@gmail.com](mailto:statefaired@gmail.com) for required form to purchase reduced price tickets. Purchases must be made before the Fair begins as the form will not be honored at the gate.

## How to Enter Exhibits – Entry Form deadline is midnight on Tuesday August 10

### Guidelines for Completing Entry Form

- Enter all items that you plan to bring. There is no entry fee.
  - Retain a copy of the entry form for exhibit pick-up.

## Delivery of Exhibits --- Deadline is Saturday, August 21 at 6 pm

Entries can be delivered in person or sent by USPS, FedEx or UPS

- **In Person:** bring exhibits to the Nebraska State Fair **office**, 501 E Fonner Park Rd, Ste. 200, Grand Island NE until Friday, August 13, from 8 am – 5 pm.  
From Monday, August 16 thru Saturday, August 21, all Senior Living Exhibits are to be delivered to the Education Exhibit area in the north end of the Fonner Park Concourse. Email [statefaired@gmail.com](mailto:statefaired@gmail.com) to set up a day and time if delivering before noon on August 21. No appointment is necessary from noon – 6 pm on Saturday, August 21. **Exhibit Delivery deadline is Saturday, August 21 at 6 pm.**
  - **Drop-off/Return Sites:** There will NOT be any drop-off/return site this year.
  - **Shipping:** Refer to **Domestic Shipping Options** for shipping information. Note that USPS, UPS, & FedEx items be sent to 501 E Fonner Park Rd, Ste. 200, Grand Island NE 68801,.

## Return of Exhibits --- No Early Release

Options for the return of exhibits are:

- **In-Person:** Items can be picked up Monday, September 6th, from 6 pm to 8:00 pm or Tuesday, September 7th, 8 am to noon in the Fonner Park Concourse Education Department. Bring a list of all exhibits you want to pick up and hand the list to a Fair staff member. A copy of your entry form would work for this purpose. The staff member will then get your exhibits for you.

*Exhibits not picked up during release time, must be picked up from the Nebraska State Fair Office, 501 E Fonner Park Rd, Ste. 200, in Grand Island no later than Friday, October 29, 2021. After that, items will be donated to charity or discarded.*

## SENIOR LIVING SWEEPSTAKES

The Education Department of the Nebraska State Fair will have both Individual and Senior Living Community Sweepstakes competitions.

1. Sweepstakes points are awarded for placing and participating in each event as follows:

3rd Place	10

7th Place	6

10th Place	3
Honorable Mention	2
Participation	1

2. The six residents with the highest sweepstakes point totals will be awarded plaques.
3. The sweepstakes points for each resident from a senior living community will be added together and the top three Senior Living Communities will receive trophies. The first place Senior Living Community will also receive a \$150 grant for their craft activities. Second place will receive a \$100 grant, and third place will receive a \$50 grant.
