## GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

The Nebraska State Fair [General Livestock Information, Rules and Regulations](#) apply to this division as well as those specific rules listed below. Also note the general Nebraska State Fair livestock exhibitor information located at [www.statefair.org](http://www.statefair.org). Please contact the superintendents with any specific questions you may have after reviewing these rules.

## HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All Llamas and Alpacas must meet Livestock Health Requirements. Refer to [Health Requirements](#) section.

**IN STATE:** CVI required.

**OUT OF STATE:** CVI required. Having obtained a permit for entry; and over six (6) months shall be negative for brucellosis and tuberculosis within sixty (60) days prior to entry into Nebraska.

## ENTRY FEES

**Llama/Alpaca Halter and Walking Fiber Entry Class Fee: \$15.00** (per animal/per class)

**Llama/Alpaca Performance/Showmanship, driving Entry Class Fee: \$15.00** (per animal/per class)

**Required ALSA animal fee: \$5.00** - ALL exhibitors must pay an ALSA show fee per animal shown, as well as the parent of produce of dam and/or get of sire, even though she or he is not shown.

**ALSA SHOW LEVEL II (NON-ALSA MEMBERS):**

**Non-member fee is \$50.00 for adults and \$15.00 for youth.** Youth showing as handler in open classes do not have to pay non-member fee, just for youth showing in youth classes.

**Animal stalls: \$25.00 (include cardboard bedding)**

**Tack Stall ONLY: \$15.00 (no cardboard bedding)**

## ENTRY DEADLINE DATE

Entries must be made online by 8:00 p.m. on August 10, 2019.

Anyone wishing to make an entry in an Open Class after 8:00 p.m. on August 10, 2019, may do so with a double entry fee up until Midnight on August 15, 2019.

## PARKING

1. All vehicles are required to park in places designated by the Fair Management. The Fair management assumes no obligation and no liability for any theft or damage that may occur to the vehicle or its contents. No vehicle will be allowed to park for the sole purpose of advertising.
2. Designated livestock parking areas will require a permit to enter. This permit must be requested on the entry form and is for the sole use of the exhibitor.
3. All trucks 3/4 ton or larger and livestock trailers will be required, immediately after unloading, to park in designated areas.

## EXHIBITOR RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Nebraska State Fair [General Livestock Information, Rules and Regulations](#) and [Health Requirements](#) apply to this and every department. Please refer to these sections. By submitting entry to the Nebraska State Fair, you agree to and will abide by these rules.
2. All exhibitors will be eligible to compete for the Herdsmanship Awards.
3. The llamas and alpacas will be housed in the Aurora Cooperative Pavilion (formerly the Swine Barn). Any alpaca or llama being housed in the Swine Barn by an exhibitor must be entered in the show and will follow the published entry fees, health requirements/certifications, arrival dates, departure times, herdsmanhip guidelines, and fair/show rules and regulations.

## STALLS & PENS

All animals occupying stalls or pens must be entered for competition and be shown in the arena in their respective ALSA or composite classes.

Nursing baby llamas brought with their dams must be entered in the costume class to fulfill the requirement of stall occupation. Both dam and baby can show as one unit in costume.

Stalls and pens will not be reserved unless application is accompanied by the required fee. Stall and pen assignments will be made by the department Superintendent and in conjunction with State Fair requirements. All applications will be date-stamped when received in the office. Tack stalls may be limited based on number of exhibitors.

**Animal stalls: \$25.00 (include cardboard bedding)**

**Tack Stall ONLY: \$15.00 (no cardboard bedding)**

## HERDSMANSHIP

The Nebraska State Fair Board will offer awards to the top three (3) exhibitors in the Llama/Alpaca Division demonstrating clean, neat animals, proper storage of feed and tack and clean alleyways. **Creativity of display using the current Nebraska State Fair theme.** Exhibitors must keep the alleyway in front of their pens clean and clear of all manure, debris and feed. All manure and debris must be deposited at a place to be designated by the Superintendent. No alley will be roped off or gated not allowing the public access. Failure to comply may result in a penalty of premium money and/or ineligibility for exhibiting at a future Nebraska State Fair. See [Open Class Herdsmanship](#).

## PEDIGREES

### HALTER CLASSES:

All Llamas AND Alpacas **MUST** have ILR or CLRC registrations.

All Alpacas AOA, ARI or CLRC registrations.

**\*Performance Animals or Non-Breeders classes do not need to be registered but must have a veterinarian certificate.**

**HALTER:** All animals 5 months and older entered in approved classes, with the exception of performance classes, **must be** registered or have passed screening in the Llama Division of the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC) or Alpaca Owners Association. Non-breeder llamas do not have to be registered or have passed screening with the ILR or the CLRC. If non-breeders are not registered and wish to be in the ALSA award system and wish to show in halter, they must show in the adult non-breeder halter class.

**REQUIRED: Photocopies of registration papers must be sent with the entry form to show management verification of name and age.** Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show. Non-breeder llamas must be accompanied by a registration or veterinarian certificate verifying the animal is a gelding, a vasectomized male, or a spayed or non-reproductive female. Nursing llama mothers may not be accompanied in the ring by their babies.

## ORDER OF SHOW DISCLAIMER

The order of show is subject to change from the entry book listing pending outcome of the decision of the judge prior to show. The judge will notify all exhibitors of the order at the judge's meeting held prior to the show. The judge may also combine classes if not enough entrants to compete to meet criteria for qualifying for Grand Nationals. Judges meetings will be held 1 hour prior to start of the show each day. Any changes for order of the show will be officially announced at this time. Please be aware of this and remain flexible until final announcements are made for show times and class schedules. Thank you in advance for your consideration of this.

### **LEVEL I ALSA ALPACA HALTER SHOW**

Due to the time of year of our show we will be offering both full fleece as well as shorn fleece divisions.**

**FULL FLEECE DIVISION:** HUACAYA: Minimum staple length of 2", SURI: Minimum staple length of 3".

**SHORN FLEECE DIVISION:** HUACAYA: Maximum staple length of 2", SURI: Maximum staple length of 3".  
Either a full shorn animal or an animal with only the blanket and underbelly shearing may be entered in this category. Please check the ALSA handbook for complete regulations.
