Summary:

Reporting to the Events Manager & Entertainment & Events Director, the Merchandise Seller will assist Artist Merchandise Manager in inventory and sale of merchandise at the National Concerts during the 2024 Nebraska State Fair. This is a temporary position.

Duties and essential job functions:

- Maintain a culture that fosters Nebraska State Fair mission and values to be an exhibition focused on agriculture and educational experiences that promote families, fun, and Nebraska pride.
- Work directly with State Fair staff and artist team to coordinate the sale of merchandise.
- Work independently and follow directions.
- Handle cash and credit card payments and make change.
- Complete count-in of merchandise before doors and count out at the end of the night.
- Assist in the setup of merchandise displays as needed.
- Assist with repacking merchandise at the end of the night.
- Complete settlement at the end of the night.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must follow basic safety requirements.
- Must be able to occasionally lift up to 50 lbs., while performing the duties of this job, and may be required to stand for long periods of time; be able to lift or assist in lifting and transporting objects such as tables, chairs, boxes, etc.
- Must possess a friendly and outgoing personality and serve as a representative for the Fair.
- **Preference will be given to those able to work every day from August 25-31, 2024. Shifts will run from approximately 2 hours before doors to post-show (approximately 8 hours).**
- Must have excellent communication and customer service skills.
- Must possess basic math skills and have experience handling cash.
- Must be driven, confident, organized and an accomplished problem-solver.
